Chicago Commons operates four high-quality early childhood education centers, integrating the Reggio Emilia philosophy. This approach empowers children to discover their world and learn by leveraging their strengths, igniting long-term learning.

Chicago Commons partners with various sites across the city to expand Head Start and Early Head Start programs, providing technical assistance, coaching, and training. We also offer access to our Family Hub and Senior Services.

At Chicago Commons, we serve the whole family. Our Family Hub is a crucial link to career pathways and comprehensive support services, fostering family stability and empowering families to break the cycle of poverty and thrive across generations.
